Call to Artists

Entry Deadline: This is an open and ongoing Call.

Pacific Park Gallery, located in the Pacific Coast Medical Park, 1957 Thompson Rd., Coos Bay, invites proposals for exhibitions of all size work in all media.

About the Gallery

The Pacific Park Gallery strives to encourage innovative artists. The gallery includes three exhibit spaces: The Atrium, The Salon and The Mezzanine. The Atrium is for free-standing sculpture, textiles, installations and large wall art. The Salon is a long wide hallway featuring medium and large wall art. The Mezzanine is reserved for smaller work, including, but not limited to, hand-pulled prints, encaustics and photography.

Exhibits will hang for up to three months. Solo and small group shows are encouraged.

Eligibility: There are no regional residential limits. All work submitted for juroring must be the original work of the artist completed in the last 5 years. *Artists accepted may choose to display work that represents a body of work regardless of completion dates.*

Size and Installation: Large work is welcome and must fit through a standard double door business entryway. The artist is responsible for 3-dimensional and complicated (multi-panel) 2-dimensional installations. All 2-dimensional work must be exhibit ready with appropriate gallery hanging/mounting hardware, including wrapped wire and preferably D-ring hangers. Weight restrictions may apply.

Sales policy: The gallery is unmanned, although secure and insured. Sales are non-commission, handled directly through the artist and are the responsibility of the exhibiting artist. The gallery is open during business hours (7:30 a.m.-5 p.m., Monday-Friday). You are not required to gallery sit.

Deadlines: Submissions will be accepted ongoing. Notifications will be by email. Hanging dates will vary according to an annual schedule and the artist's availability. Deadlines for exhibit information will be determined by exhibit scheduling.

Juroring: A committee of multi-media artists will select exhibitors.

Submission: Send a CD with up to 5 images of work with image list, including sizes of originals and medium, completed entry form, and an entry check for \$30 payable to **Pacific Park Gallery**, to Pacific Park Gallery, P.O. Box 635, Lakeside, Oregon 97449. CDs must be clearly labeled with artist's name. If selected, the images may be used to promote the exhibit.
